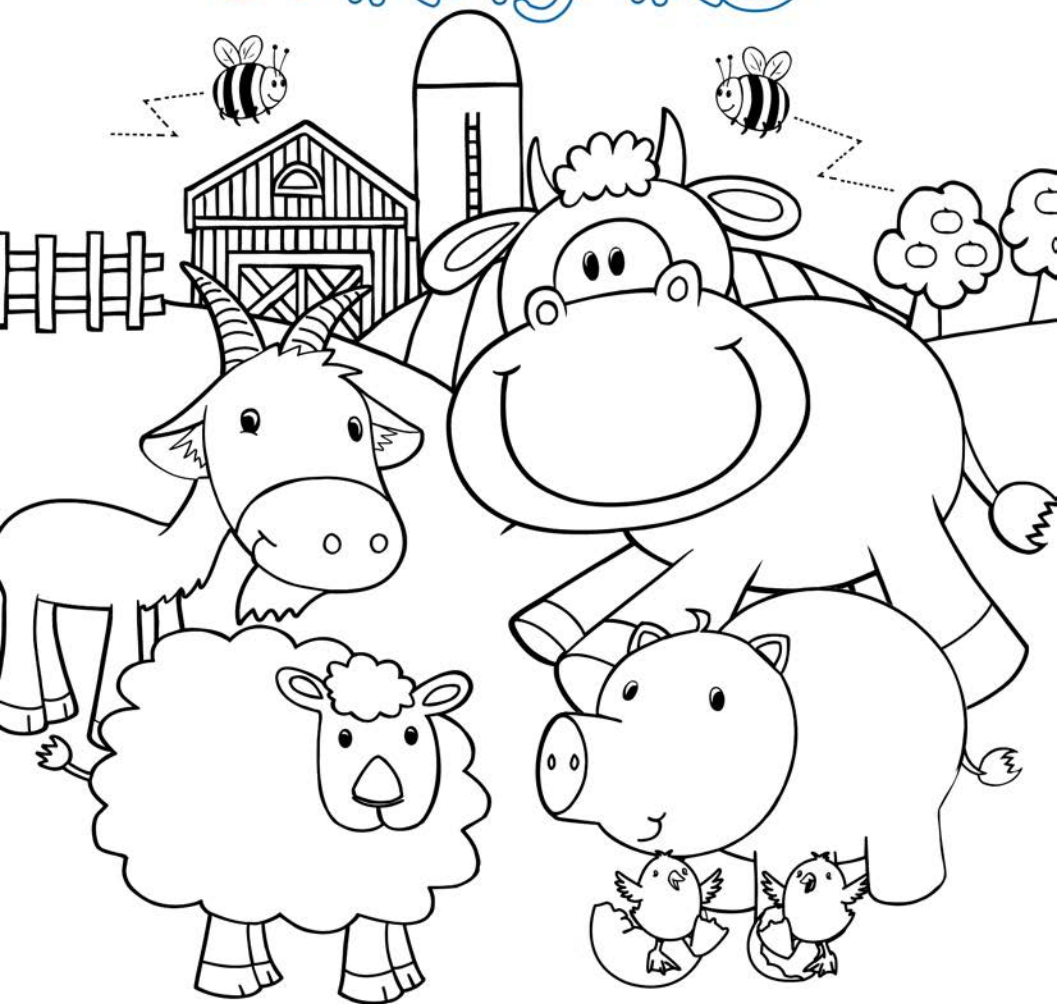


# GOD'S GLOBAL BARNYARD

## Cow

A cow's milk, meat, fertilizer and calves can quickly strengthen a family's financial security.

## Honey Bees

Bees pollinate plants and boost crop growth – helping the wider community. Soaps and candles can be made from their wax and sold at the local market.

## Goat

Fresh milk from a goat is very nutritious and can be used to make products like yogurt and cheese to sell at the market.
